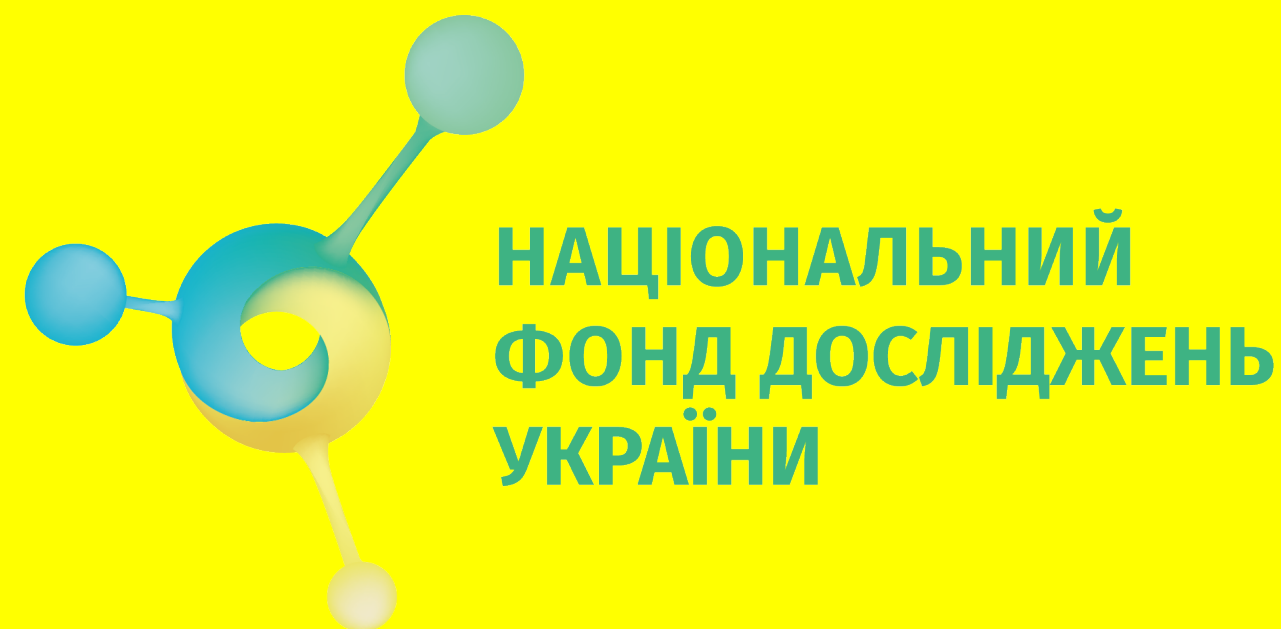
Timeline

September 1 - we started accepting applications by coordinators and members of work groups

October-November 2022 - work in groups and development of the platform, preparation of reports about damaged and destroyed scientific infrastructure, preparation of databases

December 2022 - January 2023 - deployment of the platform and publication of results
